



How to change the rock drill slider

How do I install a rock slider?

Two people may be needed to install rock slider onto the vehicle. Loosely install upper bracket screws through upper hole on rock slider assembly through vehicle and into previously installed bracket. Repeat installation for other side.

How do you make a rock slider on a 4 wheeler?

A rock slider also helps get over logs or any other natural formations in the ground you may encounter when riding your four-wheeler. To make a rock slider, start by having the truck prepped and leveled. Mount the shocks, shock mounts, and springs correctly. Now, cut out the body in the area where you want the slider to go, and weld it in place.

How do you make rock sliders on a jeep?

Making rock sliders is a straightforward and effective way to protect the sills of your jeep. These rock sliders are made from square tubing, metal plate, and high-resistance rust-resistant paint. After gathering the necessary materials, the next task is measuring how long a pair of sliders need to be. These measurements can vary for each vehicle.

How do you make a rock slider?

The rock slider consists of pre-bent and pre-cut metal tubes. You need to weld them together and mount them to vehicles. The tubes need to come up the side of the vehicles, curve down and over, and then come back up on the other side of the vehicles. This is an old cowboy trick, but it does hold out a lot of rocks.

How do you install a rear slider?

Install bracket to holes on vehicle frame located at rear of the vehicle just in front of the rear tire using screws a. Install rear slider e to front slider h using two screws j and two nuts k. Right side shown; left side similar. Torque nuts to specification. Right side shown; left side similar.

How do you attach an anchor wedge to a rock slider?

Align anchor wedges to the backside of the rock slider and loosely attach screw until anchor wedge contacts with rock slider. Make sure square part of anchor wedge is aligned with square recession in rock slider. Unthreaded and threaded anchor wedges are shipped glued together.

A common fix for this (both before or after the damage) is to install some rock sliders. Rock sliders are typically 3/16 inch metal that simply overlaps about 6 inches up the ...

Make sure you wear proper safety gear when changing out the rivet slider and that you use a hard surface to prevent any errors. Good luck and I hope this video helps. Please comment any questions ...
