



## The lead support personnel should be on the rock drill

Do commanders need to adjust the procedures for drill and ceremonies?

Since all situations or eventualities pertaining to drill and ceremonies cannot be foreseen, commanders may find it necessary to adjust the procedures to local conditions. However, with the view toward maintaining consistency throughout the Army, the procedures prescribed herein should be followed as closely as possible.

How did a Commander make a rock drill?

The commander would begin by disseminating his OORDER (Operations Order) for the mission. After his subordinates had time to process the order, they would be called together for a Rock Drill. In the Rock Drill each staff member or commander would discuss his particular role and mission during the operation.

Why do I need a rock drill?

Obviously, the Rock Drill will be instrumental to validate the NSA Functional Support Plan (formerly called the CSP) during Intelligence Campaign Planning in support of the Combatant Commanders. Each IMT that is geographically responsible for the Combatant Commander (COCOM) should use a Rock Drill to validate the Functional Support Plan.

What is a lead squad drill?

The enemy initiates direct fire contact on the lead squad. CUE: This drill begins when the enemy initiates direct fire contact. STANDARDS: The platoon lead squad locates and suppresses the enemy, establishes supporting fire, and assaults the enemy position using fire and maneuver.
